# MINUTES GREATER NAPLES FIRE RESCUE DISTRICT BOARD OF FIRE COMMISSIONERS MEETING May 8, 2018

### G. Fire Chief's Report - Chief Schuldt

Chief Schuldt reported on the following:

- Negotiations have officially started with Everglade City for Life Safety Services / Fire Marshal Services.
- NFPA has released NFPA 3000, Standard for an Active Shooter/Hostile Event Response Program. Staff will be assessing NFPA 3000 and developing our own strategy and response to hostile events.
- During a Labor Management Meeting the Union questioned why some open positions have not been filled or reclassified. Chief Schuldt stated it is because of the current budget situation.
- The Greater Naples Fire Foundation is collecting donations to support FF D. Holden.
- Cross Does GNFD pays rent to Collier County for Station 70. Schuldt -Yes. Cross directed Schuldt to advise County we are tired of waiting for action, if needed we will
  hire company to get a scope of service, get work done and withhold rent payment to
  cover County's portion of the bill.

### H. Chapter 175 Firefighters' Pension Plan – Chairman Arroyo

Deputy Director Bishop advised Chairman Arroyo was held up at brush fire. Report presented as submitted. Next Quarterly meeting May 11, 2018. Board discussed status on legal and actuary comparisons of the plans.

#### I. Local 2396 Report – President Trenton Mading

President Mading presented report as submitted. Mading stated the Local 2396 would support the GSG Study, the quicker we get it done the better – too many unknowns in the future. Our goal would be to merge with North Collier FD in 2020, one way to do that is set our millage rate the same as NCFD and add a fire assessment.
