# 1. MEET BASIC REQUIREMENTS

You will need a valid driver's license and be at least 18 years old.

# 2. MEET(AND EXCEED) EDUCATION REQUIREMENTS

You'll need a high school diploma or GED. It's also wise to become an EMT.

## 3. BE IN GOOD PHYSICAL CONDITION

Becoming a firefighter requires passing a physical ability test.

# 4. STAY OUT OF TROUBLE

How you've acted to rectify mistakes you've made is important.

# 5. KEEP YOUR SOCIAL MEDIA NOSE CLEAN

Be mindful of what you post, repost, comment on and like. Expect all potential employers to scan your social media presence.

# 6. GET INVOLVED IN YOUR COMMUNITY

Volunteering your time for a great cause is one way to prove you're ready to serve your community.

# 7. ATTEND FIRE ACADEMY

Getting your state entry-level firefighter certifications, such as Firefighter I and II, is a requirement to get hired.

### **8. PASS A WRITTEN EXAM**

Some departments have a written exam that consist of multiple choice questions and is divided into categories.

# 9. PREPARE FOR A PSYCHOLOGICAL EVALUATION

This evaluation will look at your mental and emotional stability to withstand the stresses associated with <a href="firefighting.">firefighting.</a>

# 10. BE SMOKE FREE

Be a non-smoker/non-user of tobacco products for at least one(1) year prior to application, signed affidavit.
