#### **ACTIVITIES REPORT**

<u>COVID-19</u> – EMS Chief Kevin Nelmes has done a great job coordinating testing, supplies, and vaccination efforts for the District. He has been reassigned to the Operations Section for a more efficient response to the member's and community's needs as it relates to COVID-19. The District assisted Everglades City in administering the vaccine to their 65 and older residents. Approximately 70 personnel have received the first dose of the Moderna vaccine and almost half have received their second dose. All personnel working a remote work schedule have returned to their normal work schedule. The front doors of Headquarters are now unlocked with temperature checks still in place for all who enter the building. District meeting rooms are now open for District business only.

<u>Personnel</u>- The District received notice of resignation from Battalion Commander Trent and notice of retirement from FF Joe Crato in April and Lt. Melheim in February. Fire Inspector Meredith resigned and AA Woeste and FF King were both transferred to the position of Fire Inspector in the Fire and Life Safety Section. Interviews have been held for the positions of Firefighter, Mechanic, Administrative Assistant, and Finance Technician.

<u>Promotional Testing</u>- The Professional Development Section has been conducting training for all qualified candidates sitting for the Driver Engineer promotional test. Professional Development will be working with the Local to establish a future test date for Company Officer testing.

<u>Local 2396 Contract Negotiations</u>- Staff was successful in negotiating a tentative agreement with Local 2396 after discussion of concerns raised by the Board. The agreement and MOU regarding a Battalion Chief vacancy will be brought before the Board for ratification.

<u>Fleet</u> – Total repairs for January- \$100,099; Cost for parts \$45,296. Fleet is working with Operations to secure future apparatus replacements.

<u>Hose and Ladder Testing</u>- The Logistics Section completed testing of 64,600 feet of fire hose and 83 ground ladders this month.

<u>LODD</u>- There were 19 firefighter fatalities reported by the United States Fire Administration for the month of January. May they rest in peace.



#### **BACKGROUND:**

The District has a signed Letter of Intent to purchase approximately 10 +- acres of industrial zoned land in the White Lake Corporate Park. The Fire District's agent is Dougall E. H. McCorkle Commercial Associate, Premier Commercial, Inc. 4300 Gulf Shore Boulevard North Naples, FL.

The two parcels are 5.01 +- acres each for a total acreage of 10.02 acres. The properties are lots 17 and 18 of White Lake Corporate Park.

The District has come to an agreement to purchase the property at \$5,300,000 from Plover Group Properties LLC.

Staff sought out professional services to provide the best interest rate and terms for the financing of this property. First Horizon Bank has been selected as the most responsible response to request for proposals. They will finance the project for 10 years at a 2.125 % interest rate with quarterly payments to include principal and interest.

The site will be master planned to include training, fleet, logistics, and a portion to include a headquarters and a life safety facility. The 10 acres will be capable of being a Greater Naples Fire Rescue Complex.

#### **RECOMMENDATION:**

Staff recommends to purchase ten +- acres in the White Lake Subdivision and accept the financing from Horizon Bank

#### FUNDING SOURCE / FINANCIAL IMPACT:

The First Horizon Bank has agreed to Finance \$4,000,000, the District will use Impact fees for the down payment of \$1,300,000. \$100,000 to be released as good faith down payment while due diligence takes place.

#### **MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING (MOU)**

#### **Battalion Commander/Battalion Chief Positional Vacancies**

- The Greater Naples Fire-Rescue District, or "District", in cooperation with IAFF Local 2396, ١. Collier Professional Firefighters & Paramedics, or "Union" have reached through the collective bargaining process the following mutual covenants related to filling the vacancy in the Battalion Commander/Battalion Chief Position created by a recent resignation.
- This MOU shall supersede any current contract language in conflict with the provisions II. provided below. This MOU begins upon ratification of the Union and the Board of Commissioners and ceases with the first District Battalion Commander/Battalion Chief promotional exam under the successor agreement that takes effect the first pay period of June 2021, which begins May 31st of that year.
- Battalion Commander/Battalion Chief Vacancy: The vacancy of Battalion III. Commander/Battalion Chief position will be filled through a competitive independent Board of evaluators from outside agencies within Collier County that have achieved the rank of Battalion Chief or above ranging from three to five evaluators. The evaluators will ask a range of questions to the candidates and score their responses. All candidates shall receive the same questions scored by the same evaluators. A facilitator shall be present to aid the evaluators in understanding the Fire District policies, guidelines, operations, and culture of the District. The Fire Chief or their designee shall choose the evaluators with consultation with the Union.
- IV. Qualifications and Request for Consideration: The following conditions must be met in order to be considered for the position of Battalion Commander/Battalion Chief.
  - A. Request for Consideration: An employee wishing to be considered for the position of Battalion Commander/Battalion Chief will submit a professional resume in a timely manner as determined by the Fire Chief or their designee. The resume will be provided to each evaluator at the time of interview. Evaluators will review the employee's resume, and may ask questions as desired.
  - B. Time-in-Service/Time-in-Rank: An employee wishing to be considered for the position of Battalion Commander/Battalion Chief will have a minimum of 14 years continuous service with the District. The employee will be currently serving as a Shift Lieutenant or Shift Station Captain within the organization with a minimum of 4 years' experience. These requirements will be meet at time of resume submission.
  - C. Fire Service Qualifications: The employee at the time of submitting a resume will have an Associate degree from an accredited college, or seeking an Associate degree from an accredited college (copy of transcript shall be provided). The employee will be a State of Florida Fire Officer II, and State of Florida Fire Instructor I.

- D. <u>Preference Points</u>: The following preference points will be added to the candidates average score at the completion of the evaluation:
  - 1. State Fire Officer III = .25 point
  - 2. State Fire Officer IV = .50 points
  - 3. State Fire Instructor II = .25 point
  - 4. State Fire Instructor III = .50 points
  - 5. Previous experience as an Alternate Battalion Chief = 1.0 point
- E. <u>Resume</u>: An employee shall provide all the certifications for preference points in their resume. Certifications will not be accepted after the employee has submitted their resume.
- V. <u>Candidate Listing</u>: At the completion of the interview process, the combined average score from the Board of Evaluators and the employee's preference points will be added together to establish their listing of eligibility for promotion to the Battalion Commander/Battalion Chief Vacancy. This list shall continue and be in effect until the District provides a comprehensive promotional exam under the provisions of the successor agreement. Any vacancy in a position of Battalion Commander/Battalion Chief will be filled from this list if they occur prior to the District providing notification of testing under agreement.
- VI. <u>Fire Chief Selection</u>: The Fire Chief may choose between the top two candidates for a position. The Fire Chief may interview the top two candidates in order to make the promotional consideration. It is at the Fire Chief's discretion that the vacancy will be filled.
- VII. Maintenance of Position: Any employee promoted to the position of Battalion Commander/Battalion Chief will achieve within 4-years from the date of appointment a Bachelor Degree from a Nationally Accredited College or Regional Association, and a State of Florida Fire Instructor III Certification. Any employee accepting the promotion does so with the understanding that they will meet the requirements under contractual agreement with the District. Failure to achieve or maintain qualifications will result in the demotion to the rank previously held by the employee. This provision is only applicable to those promoted under its provisions.
