



About Us

The organization is the largest independent fire district in the State of Florida, providing emergency response and life safety services to the Chokoloskee, Everglades City, Golden Gate, East Naples, Isles of Capri, Port of the Islands, and surrounding communities. The Fire District is governed by a Board of five elected Fire Commissioners, and proudly staffs over 240 uniform firefighters and civilian support staff. The Fire District deploys emergency apparatus from 16 fire-rescue stations. In addition, the Fire District manages a variety of support operations from six additional facilities including Administration, Fire & Life Safety, Training and Special Operations, Logistics, and Fleet Maintenance.

Our fire service professionals provide services to more than 160,000 residents living and working within the District's 1,512 square miles. In 2022, our fire service professionals responded to 28,299 emergency incidents and conducted 10,198 life safety inspections within the Greater Naples Fire Rescue District and Collier County at-large.

As a Firefighter, you will be responsible for general fire fighting work in the extinguishment, prevention and protection of life and property in the Greater Naples Fire Rescue District. The work requires a knowledge and understanding of fire fighting methods and techniques which are gained by training and experience. The position requires performance of tasks under emergency conditions including medical emergencies and includes the operation of the fire truck, pumpers, rescues, and related equipment. Additional duties include providing emergency medical care. In addition to emergency response, time is spent training, inspecting, maintaining equipment and quarters. Work is performed as a member of a team.

Compensation and Benefits

Annual Salary: \$55,421.68 Full time employees are eligible for additional pay based on certificates and education. Attractive benefits package including, medical, dental, vision, life insurance, short/long term disability, paid time off, and inclusion in the Florida Retirement System.

Position Requirements

- High school graduate or equivalent
- Current State of Florida issued Certificate of Compliance or Firefighter II Certification
- Current State of Florida Emergency Medical Technician or Paramedic License
- Candidate Physical Abilities Test (CPAT) passing score attained within the past 12 calendar months
- Current Healthcare Provider CPR Certified
- EVOC Certified
- Wildland fire certificates S-130 and S-190
- National Incident Management Systems (NIMS) ICS 100, 200, and 700
- Current Florida Driver's License
- Be a non-smoker/non-user of tobacco for at least one (1) year prior to application, signed affidavit required.

To claim Veteran's preference, a copy of your DD214 must be submitted at the time of application.

All applications must contain copies of certificates/licenses in to order to be processed. Selected candidates will start on Monday, March 4, 2024

Applications will be accepted through Friday, January 5, 2024. Employment applications should be accompanied by a cover letter, resume, and diplomas/certificates/licenses in order to be considered. **Incomplete applications will not be processed.**
