I. MEETING OPENED

A. AIW-Resolution No. 2024-06 Future Direction of the District and Strategic Plan- Interim Fire Chief Wolfe

Interim Fire Chief Wolfe presented the AIW as submitted. There was a discussion on adjusting the language for the ballot.

Commissioner Cherney moved to tighten up the language so that it is strictly for capital projects, and that no future reallocation of funds can be moved to operations. Commissioner Duffy seconded.

Todd Eschmann from the public stated the need for the additional funding for additional stations and firefighters; he also stated that the 8-year sunset and the limitations on where the District funds can be used, ties the Districts hands.

Interim Chief Wolfe recommended the Board to table this item and work on new language for the ballot.
