Leadership Collier at Naples Airport







Dr. Dunavant to participate in "Racing The Planet" for charity

Dr. Dunavant will be participating in a ultramarathon this coming March called "Racing the Planet" to benefit Global Response Medicine (GRM). The Atacama Crossing is a 7-day, 250km/155 mile footrace that that takes place in the incredible Atacama Desert of Chile. Through seven days, competitors traverse through salt flats, massive sand dunes, icy cold slot canyons, river crossings and experience starry nights while in the foothills of the Andes mountains as they complete the course. The race goes through the Salara de Atacama, Moon Valley, and Valle de la Muerte, and finally ends in the Town Square of the adobe-like village of San Pedro de Atacama. Dr. Dunavant will have to carry all of his own gear and food for the entirety of the race. He will be wearing dog-tags that commemorate three of GRM's very important people who were lost in a two-week span, along with dog-tags he made with his kids' names for the greater motivation he may need. GRM is a veteran founded, international NGO that delivers front line, emergency medical care for people displaced by conflict, war or disaster, for both rapid response and for long-term sustainability.
